SEC publishes the provisional list of candidates for the 2022 Municipal Elections



In compliance with article number 28 of the Electoral Calendar for the 2022 Municipal Elections, on September 13, the Supreme Electoral Council (SEC) of Nicaragua provisionally published the list of candidates for Mayors, Vice-Mayors, and members of the Municipal Councils of the 153 municipalities of the country.

In the 2022 Municipal Elections to be held on November 6, Nicaraguans will elect 8,078 public servers. That is to say, the 37,098 candidates presented among all the Political Parties and Alliances.

of Political Parties, distributed in all the municipalities of the country, and that have been provisionally published in the Gazette, Official Diary, fulfilling all the established requirements.

The SEC states that for the 2020 electoral process, it is guaranteeing gender equity, rigorously enforcing the concept of alternation, in the candidacies presented by the different Political Organizations.

Likewise, activity number 03 was carried out, which involved the period for contesting candidacies between September 14 and 18.

Consequently, on the established dates, the corresponding resolution will be issued and the definitive publication of candidates for the 2020 Municipal Elections will be carried out, thus complying with the Political Constitution of the Republic of Nicaragua and Law No. 333, Electoral Law.

The Superior Electoral Council reaffirms once again its commitment to continue strengthening democracy, peace, and stability working to guarantee all Nicaraguans a Free, Fair, and Transparent Electoral Process.



Political Parties and Alliances of Political Parties Present Lists of Municipal Electoral Councils



The Supreme Electoral Council (SEC) of Nicaragua, from September 8 to 10, successfully carried out the period of Presentation of Lists of candidates to form the Municipal Electoral Councils by the legal representatives of Political Parties and Alliances of Political Parties, which participate in the Municipal Elections on November 8.



All this is in full compliance with activity number 18 of the Electoral Calendar. This Power of the Victorian State extends recognition to all Political Organizations, for the timely and appropriate presentation of their lists.

The SEC highlights compliance with the principle of gender equity in all democratic spaces, also strictly guaranteeing the concept of alternation in the presentation of lists to members of the Municipal Electoral Councils, where 50% percent (50%) must be women and 50% percent (50%) men.



Consequently, it is clarified that according to the Law, at the time of the appointments of the Municipal Electoral Councils, in cases where the total number of Councils to be integrated in each department results in an odd number, fifty per cent (50%) must be appointed plus one gendered over by women in compliance of the second paragraph of the article 16, law No. 301, electoral law.

Therefore, 78 women and 74 men presidents of the Municipal Electoral Councils will be appointed, in the 152 municipalities of the country. Likewise, the principle of alternation is fulfilled to complete the remaining appointments, with the other methodological elements already detailed in the same Law.

In this sense, the electoral roll is granted the Political Parties and Alliances of Political Parties the time established by the Electoral Law for the presentation of their proposals.

The members of the Units of Municipal Electoral Councils must comply with the requirements mandated by the Political Constitution of the Republic of Nicaragua and Law No. 305, Electoral Law.



Consequently, September 18, is the date established for the appointment of the members of the Municipal Electoral Councils was made, for later on September 21, according to the Electoral Calendar, they take possession of their responsibilities, for the 2022 Municipal Elections to be held on 06 next November.

SEC publishes Electoral Ethics Regulation

In compliance with the Political Constitution of the Republic of Nicaragua and with article number 02 of the Electoral Calendar, on September 13, the Supreme Electoral Council published the Electoral Ethics Regulation, which will regulate the 2022 Municipal Elections Campaign.



In this sense, the Power of the State, guaranteed the Consultation process of the Electoral Ethics Regulation, from September 8 to 9, where different legally constituted Political Organizations presented their observations, for their subsequent study, analysis, and incorporation (if considered pertinent) in compliance with articles 12 and 89 of Law No. 301, Electoral Law.

With this important document, the rules of Electoral Ethics and democratic values are established, which must be preserved by Political Parties, Alliances of Political Parties, natural, and legal persons, who participate in the 2022 Municipal Elections.

Likewise, the owners of the media, directors, social communicators, presenters of communication programs in any of their modalities, officials or officers of the Electoral Power, authorities, and citizens, in general, are subject to the regulation.

Through the Electoral Ethics Regulation, the CSE promotes a climate of peace, tranquility, justice, tolerance, and peaceful coexistence in the process of the 2022 Municipal Elections to be held on November 8.
